



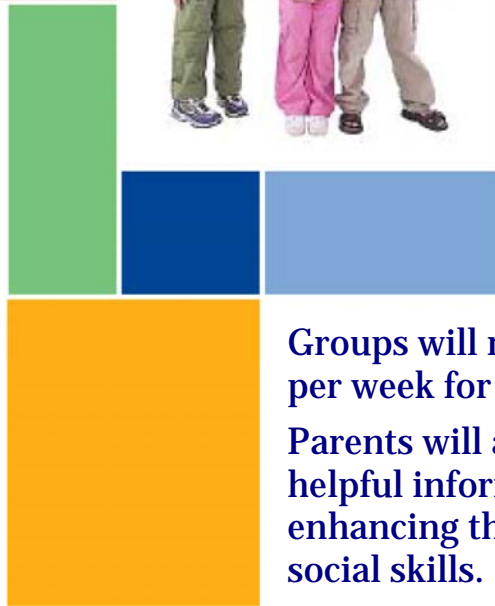
Does your child have a hard time making or keeping friends?
