

Minor in Psychology

The minor in Psychology consists of 22 hours in psychology, including the following:

- **PGS 101** Introduction to Psychology *SB* (3)
- **PSY 230** Introduction to Statistics *N2* (3)
- **PSY 290** Research Methods *L1/S2* (4)
- **PGS 315** Personality Theory and Research *SB* (3) or **PGS 341** Developmental Psychology *SB* (3) or **PGS 350** Social Psychology *SB* (3)
- **PSY 323** Sensation and Perception (3) or **PSY 320** Learning and Motivation (3) or **PSY 324** Memory and Cognition (3) or **PSY 325** Physiological Psychology (3)
- Two additional upper-division PGS or PSY courses.

A maximum of three hours of Supervised Research/Independent Study (PGS 399, 499, or PSY 499) may be used to satisfy the requirements for the minor. Internship (PGS 484 or PSY 484) cannot be used to satisfy the requirements for the minor.

All courses for the minor must be passed with a minimum grade of "C."
